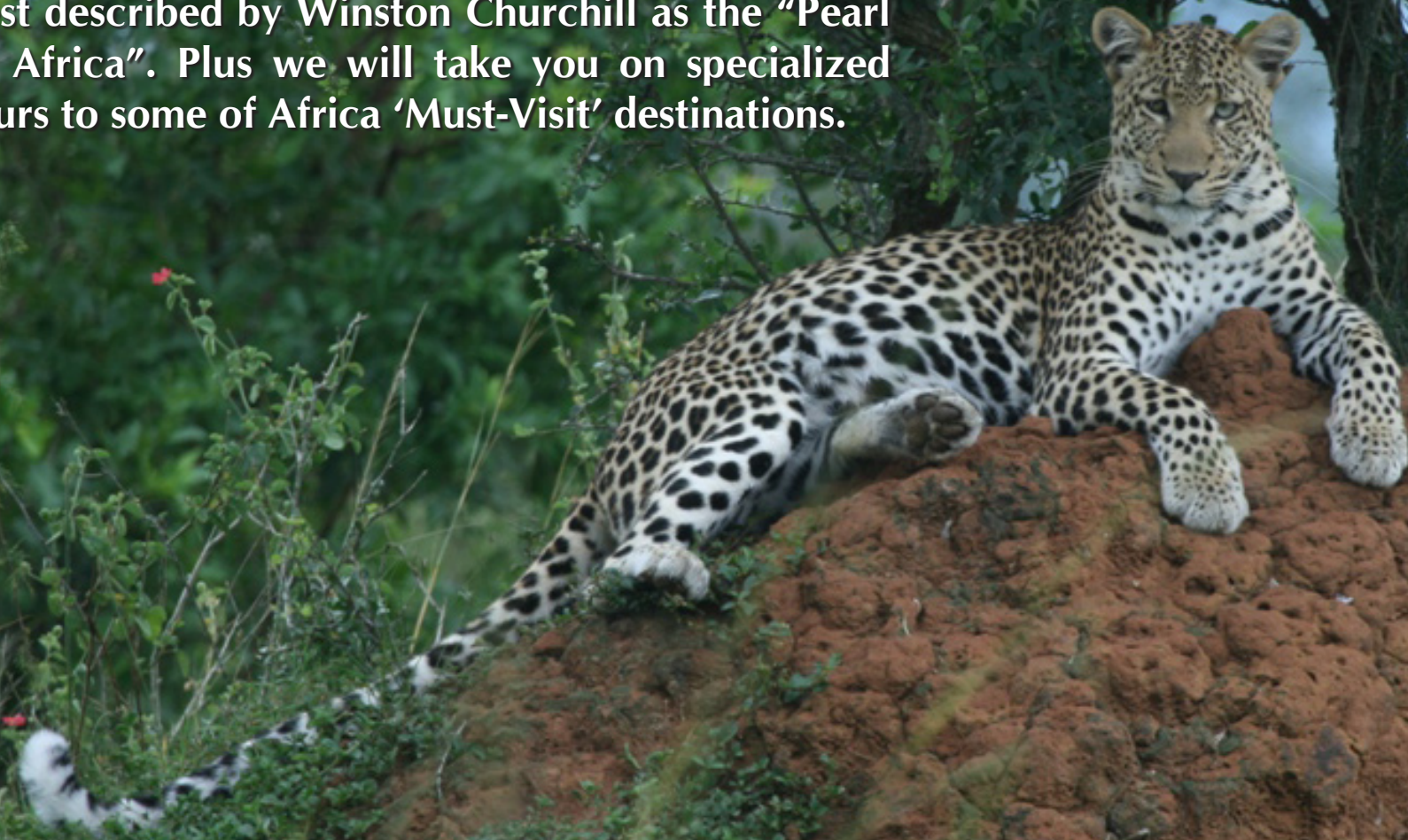

Situated in the heart of Africa and being astride the Equator gives Uganda the best climate all year round. Uganda is also home to the highest mountain ranges in Africa- the Rwenzoris. It is in Uganda that the World’s longest river “The Mighty Nile” starts its 6700km journey to the Mediterranean Sea. The Nile River is renowned for its unique rapids which rafters find very exciting. Adventure seeking tourists have unlimited options when it comes to the Nile River. In the wake of the booming tourism industry, Uganda went ahead and developed the best spot for stunt jumping in the whole world along River Nile. The beauty of Uganda extends far beyond for instance; the scenery is so striking and picturesque. The rich wildlife in 10 National Parks not to mention over 13 game reserves and having the highest concentration of primates in the world gives Uganda a voice in ecotourism. Uganda boasts of housing more than half of world’s gentle forest giants “The Mountain Gorillas”- one of the rarest mammals possessing over 90% DNA compatibility with humans. Again Uganda is the leading Avi-tourism destination in Africa. Further, the hospitality of Ugandan people is unrivalled in the world. Uganda surely is a fascinating destination for all travelers and Voyager African safaris will give a mix of activities that emphasizes your core interests plus a feel of all the others.

Nature Walks

If you'd like to be in tune with nature, you can take nature walks where you will experience the quietness of the wilderness and encounter some wildlife, a variety of birds and a rich expansive flora.

You can have a guided walk on the Munyaga River Trail, next to Bwindi Impenetrable Forest, which leads to three crystal clear waterfalls and you can also expect to see plenty of birds and primates.

You can also enjoy a nature walk in Budongo Forest, One of the best sites for primate viewing, where you will see chimpanzees.

A nature walk at Mabira Forest (the largest natural Forest in East Africa) will allow you to see a variety of birds and primates such as monkeys.

You can also take nature walks in the Kyambura gorge, next to Queen Elizabeth National Park, where you will track primates such as chimpanzees, monkeys and baboons.

A guided nature walk in the Bigodi Wetland Sanctuary offers great birding opportunities and primate viewing. You will be able to see over 137 bird species and primates like Bush babies and colobus monkeys.



Gorilla Safaris

This safari will take you to Bwindi Impenetrable National Park for mountain Gorilla tracking. Bwindi is home to 326 gorillas, almost a half of the world's population of Mountain Gorillas. It is estimated that only about 700 Mountain Gorillas are remaining worldwide. The park has about 120 species of mammals including 7 diurnal primates and about 30 elephants. Bwindi Impenetrable forest also offers a unique birding opportunities, cultural experiences, and scenic allure of stunning hills and lush vegetation inhabited by the elusive primates and pygmies. Therefore tracking some of the last remaining closest relatives of man (with over 90% DNA compatibility) is an unforgettable experience.

Cultural Tourism



Uganda has a very strong culture heritage. Our cultural tours allow you to sample the vibrant lifestyle and rich cultures of our indigenous people.

Not to be missed, are the rare experiences of interacting with some of the local communities which includes a local Pygmy community in the West, Karamajong cattle keepers in the North, the Bahima Cattle keeper in the West; as well a visit to some of our cultural sites such as the Museum, the Bahai Temple (the only one in Africa), Heritage sites such as the Karambi & Kasubi Tombs, Martyrs Shrines, Nyero Rock Paintings and Crafts centers.

Chimpanzee Trekking

Chimpanzees are more closely related to human beings (about 98% DNA compatibility) far more than any other living creature and are tremendously fun to watch. Uganda has about 4,950 Chimpanzees.

Take a trip to the most accessible of Uganda's major rainforests, Kibale National Park, where you can expect to see chimps de-nesting (coming out of their nocturnal nests), creating new nests and doing their other daily activities in their natural habitat.

You can also enjoy chimpanzee viewing at the Ngamba Islands Chimpanzee Sanctuary. The island is home to about 39 chimpanzees. On the island, you will have the privilege of seeing the chimpanzees up close. You will view their morning feeding from the raised visitors' platform along the edge of the sanctuary's fence. It's fascinating to watch the chimps interact with each other and with their care givers. You will also observe the various personalities in the group; with some whistling for food and others clapping.

Uganda boasts several types of mammals including the BIG 5 making it spectacular game territory.

Game lovers can expect to see animals including Lions, Leopards, Elephants, Buffaloes, Rhinos, Giraffes, Jackals, Lions, Hyenas, Hartebeests, Oribis, Uganda Kobs, zebras, monkey, Impala, waterbucks, elands, buffaloes, Hippos, Impalas, topi, Bohor reedbuck, sitatunga antelope, klipspringer, vervet monkey, olive baboon, side-striped Jackal and white-tailed mongoose.

Game viewing safaris are done in several of our National Parks including Queen Elizabeth National Park, Murchison Falls National Park, Kidepo National Park and Lake Mburo National Park.



Birding Safaris

Uganda boasts more than half the bird species found on the entire African continent making it the perfect birding destination. We have over 1000 species of birds some of which are unique only to Uganda. This safari will take you through our vast national parks, deep into our forests and along our swamps where you will see several birds' species including the famous Shoebill, pelican, Jacana, black crane, heron, cormorant and fish eagle, Emerald-spotted Wood, Crested Francolin, Bare-faced Go-away-bird, Lilac-breasted Roller, Spot-flanked Barbet, Nubian Woodpecker, Brown parrot, Trilling Cisticola, Northern Black Tit, Marico Sunbird, Chin-spot Batis, Blue-eared Starling, Coqui Francolin, Black-bellied Bustard, Temminck's Courser, African Wattled Plover, Rufous-chested swallow, Rufous-naped and Flappet Larks, Yellow-throated Longclaw, and Southern Red Bishop among others. Our birding experts will take you to some of the top bird watching destinations which include Budongo Forest, Kibale Forest, Queen Elizabeth National Park and Bwindi Impenetrable Forest.





Murchison Falls National Park

No trip to Uganda is complete without a visit to the world renowned Murchison Falls. The most impressive and breathtaking view is at the top, where the Nile forces its way through a seven-metre gap in the rocks before tumbling 40 metres down, creating a thunderous roar. You will also get the rare opportunity to hike up to the top of the falls.



The Equator

Uganda and Kenya are among the few countries that lie on the Equator. You can visit the point where the equator is said to pass through Uganda, where you can also take some photographs and souvenirs.



Semuliki National Park

Not to be missed are the Sempaya Hot Springs. The outer spring is dominated by a boiling geyser (103°C) which spurts 2Metre high. This is a sight not to be missed! You can also enjoy the rare experience of boiling eggs in the bubbling pools created by this hot water. Also not to be missed is the 30 minute trail through beautiful palm forest to the inner hot spring, which is a broad, steaming pool stretching about 10m across.



The Source of the Nile

No trip to Uganda is complete without a visit to the source of the River Nile at Jinja. It is believed that at this spot, the Mighty River Nile begins its 6,700 Km journey through Egypt into the Mediterranean Sea.

The serene gardens here are very spacious with a variety of indigenous birds and monkeys. There is also a beautiful view of Lake Victoria the world's largest fresh water lake.

A boat trip across the River will give you the opportunity to have a good time and at the same time you will be able to view a variety of birdlife.



Tree Climbing Lions

A drive through the Ishasha sector will reward you with the opportunity to see the famous tree climbing lions found only in Uganda and in Lake Manyara National Park in Tanzania. The lions climb into the Acacia trees and Fig Trees to escape the heat and spend the entire day, sleeping in the tree branches

You can enjoy a boat trip along the 32km Kazinga channel, at Queen Elizabeth National Park, which is believed to contain the world's highest concentration of hippos.

Grade Five White Water Rafting

Adventure lovers can indulge in water sports such as white water rafting at the world famous Bujagali Falls along the Nile River.

Uganda offers world-class white water rafting and Prince William is among the celebrities who have gone down this classic grade 5 rapids.

This trip is guaranteed to get your heart pumping and adrenaline flowing. The Nile River provides one of the best rapids and can accommodate any level of rafter. No experience is needed.

Bunjee Jumping

One of the best spots for stunt jumping and bungee jumping is developed along the Nile River in Uganda. We offer you the chance to challenge your fear of heights by bungee jumping over the Source of the Nile.



a) Rwenzori Mountain Climbing

Adventure lovers can climb the legendary “Mountains of the Moon” (as described by Ptolemy in A.D. 150), The Rwenzoris. Enjoy a challenging hike to the highest peak - Margherita peak, the highest at 5109m named after the Italian Queen Margherita who sponsored the first climbing expedition. This peak is permanently snow-capped despite being astride the Equator. Its beautiful sceneries: ox-bow lakes, hanging valleys, Crater lakes, cliffs, waterfalls, and rivers plus ever green tropical rain forests forms a natural habitat for various flora and faunas including humans “Bakonjo-pyg-mies”. Climbing The Rwenzoris is the toughest expedition and yet most rewarding adventure in Africa.



b) Mt. Elgon Climbing

Enjoy the thrill of climbing to the top of Mt. Elgon. No mountaineering skills are required and the whole region is excellent for hikers and climbers. A major attraction to this park is Sipi Falls at the foot of the Mountain. You can also expect to see a variety of wildlife including buffalo, elephants and monkeys. The area is also swarming with birdlife. Other attractions include cave paintings, caves and hot springs within the crater.
